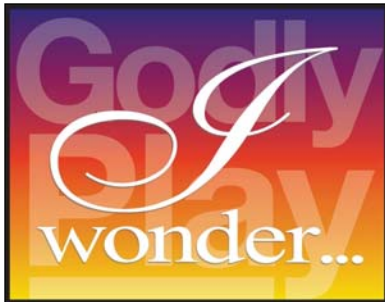




Godly Play

Godly Play is a Montessori-based approach to enhancing the spiritual life of children using biblical stories and constructed artifacts for story telling.

Developed over three decades in the USA and Europe by Rev. Jerome Berryman, Godly Play's respect for and attention to childhood spirituality and the use of story to develop spirituality address goals common to both Christians and Jews. A popular form of religious education in churches throughout the USA and

Europe, Godly Play has been piloted by Jewish communities in Indiana, London and Melbourne Australia.

This training workshop, facilitated by Rev. Cheryl Minor, Godly Play trainer and pastor, All Saints Church, and Rabbi Dr. Michael Shire, Dean and Professor of Jewish Education, Hebrew College, will initiate a research project being developed by Hebrew College's Shoolman Graduate School of Jewish Education.

Cost of the workshop is \$85 per person (includes Sunday dinner and Monday lunch; dietary laws observed). There are a limited number of spaces available.
